BDA Update – Moline PD and Davenport PD are both cabled and now waiting on certain equipment to finish install. Rock Island County Sheriff Office and Scott County Sheriff Courthouse and Jail are both still waiting on plans from RACOM and Anixster to finalize plans with the BDA's.
