Roll call was completed.

Moved by Jeff Snyder, seconded by Tracey Sanders, approval of the Minutes of the April 28, 2021, QC P25 Intergovernmental Advisory Group. All ayes.

An SOP update was given. All changes that were submitted by the various reviewers have been made. Work will continue on the other polices. Would like to plan a meeting outside of this group to work and develop polices.

Fleet mapping is complete up to this point. Once radio system goes live there will be more work. Will start to look and have conversations on local Interop Channels.

Discussion was had about the RACOM Maintenance System Agreement. SECC will be approving their agreement at the June SECC Board meeting.

Illinois advised that their board approved System Access fees for oncoming agencies. They advised that for the first year of a 5 year agreement agencies will pay \$15 per device and then will move to \$25 a year for years 2 through 5.

SECC advised that they will be having that discussion when they talk about the Maintenance System Agreement at the next board meeting.



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A policy may need to be developed for an agency that brings a lot of usage to the system. Will need to discuss further at a later time.

A brief update on tower construction was given by both states.

No public comments.
