Roll call was completed.

Jeff Snyder motioned to approve the meeting minutes from the May 25, 2022 meeting. Steve Knorrek seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion passes.

Project Update Discussion – Believe that all access control issues at the Oak Glen site were fixed. Can see all camera views at the tower sites. The old Silvis Tower is set to be decommissioned later this month. The Iowa side is going to schedule someone to go out monthly to look at sites.

Migration Plan Update – On the Illinois side all core agencies made the transition to the P25 system. Rock Island Jail is still waiting on making their transition. Working with other agencies to make the transition that have signed up to be on the system. The Iowa side is still waiting to transition Davenport Police, Davenport Fire, Scott County Sheriff and Jail. Waiting on BDA's to be installed at their respective buildings.

BDA Update – Davenport PD BDA is complete but turned off until ready to transition. Still waiting on plans for the Scott County Courthouse and Jail. Moline PD BDA is complete and turned on. Just approved the plans for Rock Island County Sheriff Department at 3 different locations. There have been recent discussion about installing BDA's at the TaxSlayer Center in Moline. Bettendorf Police reporting have a few issues in their buildings. Will do some testing to see if they need a BDA installed. Going to work with some of the local hospitals to test their facilities for BDA's.

Sam Fleege provided an update on the schedule to get fire paging started for fire departments that are on pagers. Dave Donovan advised that Davenport CitiBus is looking to join the system.
