MINUTES (for approval) QC P25 INTERGOVERNMENTAL ADVISORY GROUP WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 23, 2020, 2:00 P.M.

Chair Hart called the meeting to order at 2:02 P.M. Roll call was completed.

Moved by Tracey Sanders, seconded by Jeff Snyder, approval of the Minutes of the November 18, 2020, QC P25 Intergovernmental Advisory Group. All ayes.

Hart first discussed the VIDA Core and if it was connected yet. Sam Fleege advised that they are finishing up the process and have had no issues to this point.

A Policy and Procedure Subcommittee group was developed with members consisting of Darren Hart, Ron Erickson, Dave Donovan, Tracey Sanders, and Steve Knorrek. Discussed amongst the whole group was various policies. Advised that rough drafts have been drawn up for Agency Access and Start-up. The subcommittee will continue to work and look at other policies and bring to the group for further discussion. Medic is willing to show how their policy program works, as they already share with SECC and other ambulance groups.

The members also discussed options for keeping track of financial and reporting issues once the towers and P25 radio system is running. Members each gave what they use in their own agencies and will look at further details of those.

Continued further discussion on talk groups. Illinois advised finishing up meetings with PD and has a meeting scheduled for January 6th. There is a meeting scheduled for January 13th with the FD to discuss fire-ground talk groups. Illinois is hoping to have everything finalized by the end of January.

Tracey advised that SECC is almost complete with all their talks. Having the final discussions of the single key encryption talk with the police departments. Sanders advised that everything should be finalized by January 15th except for EMS talk groups.
